The Show & Sale is this weekend!

Show setup details and general information:

* Our show and sale is March 23 & 24th and will be in Woodland Hall and Garden Room new exhibit area, in the old library location by East Blvd exit.

* March 22 - April 28th is CBG's "Big Spring" event. The preview party is March 22nd at 6pm, which limits our setup time and entrance access. We will setup Friday afternoon March 22nd, 2- 5:30 pm and we can return Saturday at 7am. We enter at the East Blvd doors and unload in the pull off area. We will have carts and several men to help unload cars and move plants inside quickly, especially if it's cold. If no one's around when you arrive, call Karen's cell 440-415-3949 or Bill's cell 440-339-4720 and tell us you're there. Cell phones work in show area, not in parking garage. After unloading, park in garage. Security will lock the doors to the show/sale area when we leave Friday.

* Security has a list of those working each day. Enter through parking garage when you arrive and check in at security office where they'll validate your parking ticket, otherwise you'll pay CBG admission and parking.

* Plant vendor is Bill Hendricks; Bill will have cactus soil, topper and pumice for sale.

* Kevin White will be selling rock planters and dish gardens, as well as displaying his collection.

* Bill Hendricks will present 'Baja Sur; Exploring Roads Less Traveled' at 2 pm each day in Hershey Classroom.

* Nancy will bring cashbox, change, and 2 calculators with paper rolls; Karen will have supplies, handouts, nametags, plant labels...

* Everyone...bring small & medium boxes, fast food drink trays, newspaper, and paper and plastic bags for packing customer plants. Long, shallow boxes don't work well if not sturdy.

* Beverly is ordering a dozen more aprons for members working the show, so we'll have 22 total. Return aprons and name tags when you leave each day.

* Don't be afraid to jump in and help, volunteer, make suggestions, ask questions, assist visitors...
